


## J. WILKES 2014 KENT'S RED CENTRAL COAST

The 2014 Kent's Red shows incredibly dark fruit with pomegranates exploding. The nose draws you in with dark red fruits including blackberry, plum, fresh bread, red meats, followed with hints of roses, thyme and lavender. The entry shows both its very nice acidity and yet soft, sweet tannins. This wine unfolds into jam and cherry cola with just the right amount of oak integration.

Blend: Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot
